The Way is a Christian Retreat Center. We are committed to do all we can to make your stay enjoyable and help you draw closer to God and each other. In order to accomplish this, we need your help. The following Youth Code of Conduct is implemented to help ensure your stay is fun, safe and meaningful.

- Any emergency must be immediately reported to an adult.
- All participants must stay in the designated areas at The Way. Coyotes, bobcats, rattlesnakes and other wildlife roam in the area. Absolutely no minors are allowed anywhere on the property without adult supervision.
- Do not enter into construction areas or an area where oil and gas equipment is located.
- No smoking or tobacco products are permitted.
- No alcohol or drugs are permitted. Anyone bringing these substances to The Way will be asked to leave immediately.
- No weapons or fireworks of any kind are permitted.
- No boys are permitted in girls' rooms, and no girls are permitted in boys' rooms.
- Any damage should be reported immediately to an adult.
- Please leave The Way better than you found it and clean up after yourself.
- All participants shall show Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to everyone and to the property around them through language, dress and behavior.
- Immediate corrective action will be taken to ensure the safety and welfare of all retreat participants. Additional action may be taken upon further investigation in the incident.
